Chapters of concentration that are always included in the publication include residential real estate, commercial real estate, labor markets, demographics, new residential and commercial development, the recent direction of interest rates, and quality of life indicators. Other relevant information is presented as areas of economic interest emerge over time.

The California Economic Forecast was founded in 1989 by Dr. Mark Schniepp, then director of the UCSB Economic Forecast Project.

The company develops real estate and economic forecasts for Ventura County, the Santa Clarita Valley, the Antelope Valley, San Luis Obispo City, Santa Barbara County, and the Santa Maria Valley.

The firm prepares the annual Orange and San Diego County Economic Outlooks together with the UCLA Anderson Forecast. Findings from all of these reports are regularly presented at public conferences in October and May of each year.

Annual economic forecasts are prepared for the California Department of Transportation, the California Association of Realtors, Kaiser Permanente, and the Irvine Company.
